About Us

The Tiffin Community Non-Food Pantry began serving the residents of Tiffin and Seneca County in October 2018.

The focus of the pantry is on providing, at no cost to those in need, items that cannot be purchased with SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program) or WIC (Women, Infants, and Children).

The pantry is managed by a committee under the oversight of the mission and evangelism committee of the First Presbyterian Church of Tiffin (FPC).

More than 30 volunteers assisted with the pantry in 2021 alone, including over 15 FPC members and over 15 from the community. Some volunteers “gave back”, having used the pantry themselves.

What You Should Know

- ◊ Items are pre-bagged and are distributed as people drive up in Tiffin City Lot 6 beside First Presbyterian Church.
- ◊ Individuals are granted access to amounts of items according to the size of their household.
