

The Tiffin Community
Non-Food Pantry began serving
the residents of Tiffin and Seneca
County in October 2018.

The focus of the pantry is on providing, at no cost to those in need, items that cannot be purchased with SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program) or WIC (Women, Infants, and Children).

The pantry is managed by a committee under the oversight of the mission and evangelism committee of the First Presbyterian Church of Tiffin (FPC).

More than 32 volunteers assisted with the pantry in 2021 alone, including over 20 FPC members and over 12 from the community.

Some volunteers "gave back", having used the pantry themselves.
